

RWJBH Onboarding of Students During the COVID-19 Pandemic

- The university will provide and verify an attestation that 2 negative COVID-19 tests have been obtained within the past three weeks <u>prior</u> to the beginning of their semester/clinical experience. This verification includes faculty and students. This verification responsibility lies with the university and must be added into the RWJBH existing ACADEMIC FACILITY ATTESTATION STUDENT PLACEMENT FORM's addendum: COVID-19 - ATTESTATION STUDENT PLACEMENT FORM that the university provides each hospital campus.
- 2. All instructors/students will not be assigned to any known or suspected COVID-19 patient or any patient requiring any type of isolation.
- Prior to the beginning of the clinical experience if there is an accompanying instructor, the instructor must complete a mandatory self-study that relates to the campus's specific COVID-19 processes. If there is a graduate student they must review the material supplied.
- 4. Prior to beginning the clinical experience the onsite instructor, if appropriate, will be required to meet with the unit/department leadership to receive an overview of the department processes.
- 5. All students and faculty must adhere to the screening protocols that are required by RWJBH as well as their respective university.
- 6. Upon arrival to the campus all students and faculty will follow the appropriate screening and processes as designated by RWJBH. .
- 7. Pre/Post conferences/meetings and other academic gatherings will remain in compliance with RWJBH Social Distancing policies and practices.
