



RWJBH Onboarding of Students During the COVID-19 Pandemic

1. The university will provide and verify an attestation that 2 negative COVID-19 tests have been obtained within the past three weeks prior to the beginning of their semester/clinical experience. This verification includes faculty and students. This verification responsibility lies with the university and must be added into the RWJBH existing ACADEMIC FACILITY ATTESTATION STUDENT PLACEMENT FORM's addendum: COVID-19 - ATTESTATION STUDENT PLACEMENT FORM that the university provides each hospital campus.
2. All instructors/students will not be assigned to any known or suspected COVID-19 patient or any patient requiring any type of isolation.
3. Prior to the beginning of the clinical experience if there is an accompanying instructor, the instructor must complete a mandatory self-study that relates to the campus's specific COVID-19 processes. If there is a graduate student they must review the material supplied.
4. Prior to beginning the clinical experience the onsite instructor, if appropriate, will be required to meet with the unit/department leadership to receive an overview of the department processes.
5. All students and faculty must adhere to the screening protocols that are required by RWJBH as well as their respective university.
6. Upon arrival to the campus all students and faculty will follow the appropriate screening and processes as designated by RWJBH. .
7. Pre/Post conferences/meetings and other academic gatherings will remain in compliance with RWJBH Social Distancing policies and practices.
