Program/Track Options

Family Nurse Practitioner

This post-baccalaureate (BSN) option prepares graduates to provide primary care to individuals and families across the lifespan. After completion of the program graduates can sit for a Family Nurse Practitioner certification exam.

Graduation Requirements: 47 credits

Adult Gerontological Primary Care Nurse Practitioner

This post-baccalaureate (BSN) option prepares graduates to provide primary care to individuals including young adults (including adolescents and emancipated minors), adults, older adults, and elderly. After completion of the program graduates can sit for an Adult Gerontological Primary Care Nurse Practitioner national certification exam.

Graduation Requirements: 43 credits

Post Masters Family Nurse Practitioner Option

This post masters certificate program is designed for registered nurses who have earned a master's degree in nursing and who wish to become a Family Nurse Practitioner. After completion of the program graduates can sit for a Family Nurse Practitioner national certification exam.

Program Requirements: 37 credits

Post Masters Adult Gerontological Primary Care Nurse Practitioner

This post masters certificate program is designed for registered nurses who have earned a master's degree in nursing and who wish to become an Adult Gerontological Primary Care Nurse Practitioner. After completion of the program graduates can sit for a Adult Gerontological Primary Care Nurse Practitioner national certification exam.

Program Requirements 33 credits

Neonatal Nurse Practitioner

Our TCNJ Neonatal Nurse Practitioner track is a collaborative program developed between TCNJ and Thomas Jefferson University. RN's with a BSN who have a minimum of 1-year of experience in a level 3 or 4 Neonatal Intensive Care Unit are eligible to apply to this program.

Program Requirements: 38 credits

Nurse Educator Certificate

The certificate is a 14-credit program designed for nurses who are seeking to acquire advanced knowledge in the field with special focus on teaching in an academic environment and/or healthcare setting. The certificate is available to post-baccalaureate (BSN) RN's and post-masters (MSN) RN's

Program Requirements: 14 credits

Nurse Education MSN

This post-baccalaureate (BSN) option prepares graduates to teach in classrooms, educate online or drive change in hospitals and health systems in the community to provide patient centered care.

Program Requirements: 38 credits
